Greetings from Dream Home in China.

The weather in ShenYang has been unusual. It has been raining and chilly in May. However, today I was able to take the children outside as it was sunny.

I wanted to send this newsletter to share about a young boy who has come into our care. He came to us in May and we call him "Peace" in Chinese. He is only 3 years old. Peace



was abandoned by his own daddy in the park in ShenYang. When he was found he was taken to the orphanage by a policeman. At the same time, his neighbor was wondering why the boy was not at his house. The neighbor asked his Daddy where his son was but the answer was not clear, so the neighbor reported the boy's absence to the police. The police were able to figure out where Peace's house and family where after this. Peace's parents divorced when he was 1 year old and then his daddy remarried. Two

weeks ago Peace and his caregiver watched TV news together after dinner and they saw the news story about Peace and his Daddy. Peace immediately recognized his house and neighbor and his daddy's face. Now his daddy is in the jail.

Peace is very healthy and cute. He loves to eat apple, cucumber and meat. When we were at the indoor playground he saw the KFC sign and asked me if we could go because he recognized the sign. After we played we went to KFC and he was very happy to eat fried chicken. He also likes balls, balloons, cars, and playing the card game "poker".

When he is good, he is very good but sometimes he hits people. We can imagine what his home environment was like. We don't know yet how long Peace will be with us. I asked him if he wants to go back with his Daddy when it is time. He said "No", he doesn't want to go back with his daddy. I had



tears immediately when I heard him say "No". Peace wiped my tears with his hand and told me "Don't cry". He is a very lovely boy. I have taken him to my house several times. Now he wants me to take him to my home every day. If I don't take him to my house he will cry and ask the volunteer who played with him to take him to their home. Of course, I understand his heart. I know how much he misses his daddy. Now we love him so much and I am worried about what will happen when he leaves us. I don't know yet

what decision will be made about peace and his daddy.

I would like you to join me in praying for Peace. He is mostly doing well but he will suddenly cry when he is sleepy. I am sure that he misses his daddy. Everybody was

born to be loved. Peace is worthy to be loved too. May God lead his life in the best way.
